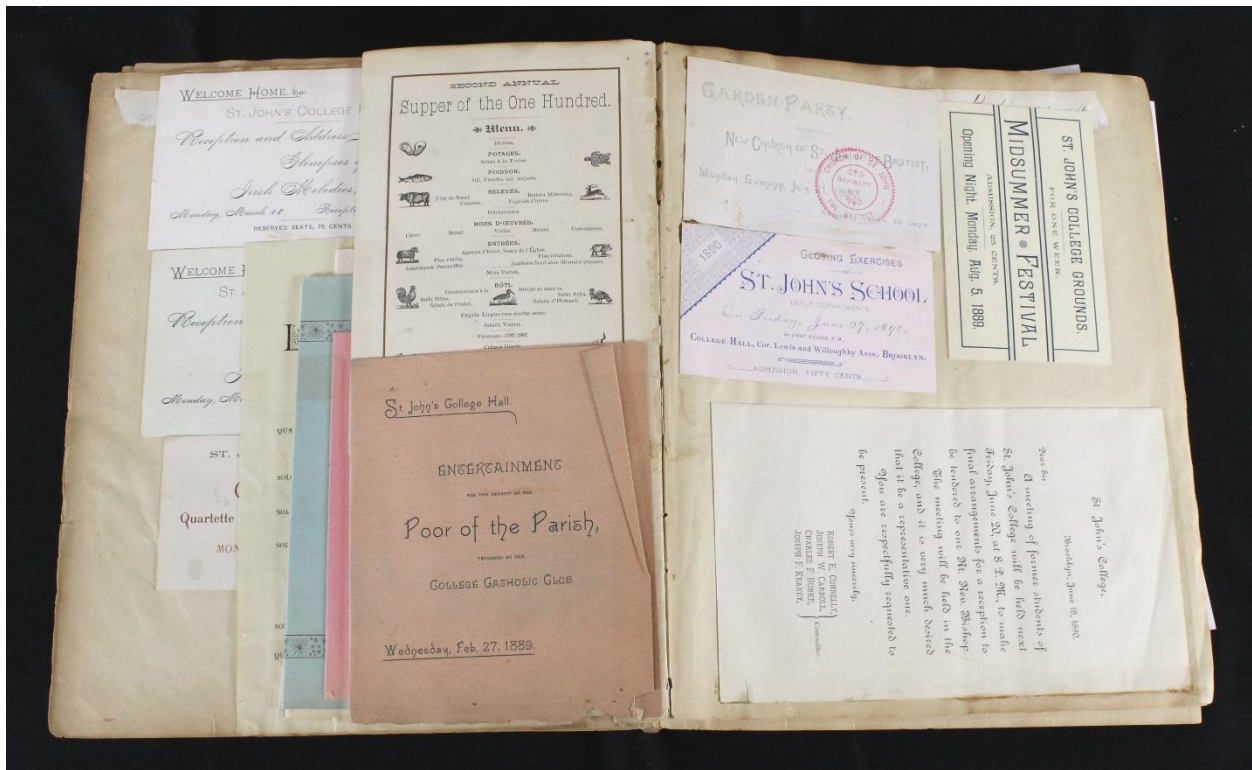

Biographical Note

Joseph W. Carroll (c.1857- ?) was a student at St. John's University from 1870-1874. He then attended St. Francis Xavier College of New York, graduating in 1879/1880. He was elected president of their alumni society in 1885. Carroll worked for the Surrogates Court as a clerk. In addition he was involved in numerous organizations including the Catholic Historical Society, the Catholic Benevolent League, and the Crack Catholic Club. He served as Vice President of the Columbian Club, Chairman of the Mitchell Memorial Fund Society, and Chairman for Father McNamara's Silver Jubilee.

Carroll served as secretary for the executive committee for the Bishop of Brooklyn John Loughlin's Golden Jubilee from 1889-1890, as well as Chief of Staff for the parade that was part of the celebration. In addition, he served as a pallbearer at Bishop Loughlin's funeral in January of 1892. In addition to his involvement in the various events for Bishop Loughlin included in this scrapbook, it is inferred that he is the original creator of the scrapbook because of a penmanship sample among the loose items in the back pages of the scrapbook, which matches the remains of correspondence long ago ripped out of the scrapbook dating to 1870 when he was a student at St. John's.

Scope and Content Note

This scrapbook contains memorabilia and newspaper clippings related to St. John's University and to the Catholic community in Brooklyn, including events held at the Lewis Avenue, Brooklyn Campus at St. John's College Hall, the Church of St. John the Baptist, the St. John's Seminary, the St. John's Parochial School, and events in celebration of John Loughlin, the first Bishop of Brooklyn (December 20, 1817-December 29, 1891). There are also programs for various events relating to the centenary celebration of the Miraculous Medal in 1930.

The majority of the items are attached to the scrapbook pages, however there are a number loose items inside the back cover and loose clippings in the bottom of the box. It appears that the scrapbook has been reused due to the remains of correspondence long ago ripped off dating to 1870 in Brooklyn.
